NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids will be received at the office of the Deuel County Auditor, PO Box 616, Clear Lake, SD for the following items of supply to be opened at the specified times on March 16, 2010 in the Deuel County Courthouse, these bids shall be effective for a period of one year, from April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011.

9:15 a.m. – Treated and Untreated Bridge Lumber, Piling and Hardware. FOB any point in Deuel County.

9:20 a.m. – Hot and Cold Mix Asphalt as required. The bid price shall be stated per ton, at plant.

9:25 a.m. – Bituminous Road Oil and Emulsions, to be delivered in insulated transports, at application temperatures. Demurrage charges shall be stated. FOB any point in Deuel County.

9:30 a.m. – Fuel - #1 Diesel, #2 Diesel, and Hi-speed Diesel or equivalent, delivery to various points in Deuel County, as required.

9:35 a.m. – Unleaded gas and gasohol – delivered to Deuel County Highway shop.

9:40 a.m. - Propane (LP) – delivery to 4-H Service Center, Bemis, Brandt, Clear Lake and Gary Highway shops.

9:50 a.m. – Rental or lease of miscellaneous equipment for road construction and maintenance.

10:05 a.m. – Gravel Crushing to be done at various pits in Deuel County. Price requested for ¾”, 5/8” and ½” sizes.

10:20 a.m. – Reinforced Concrete Culvert, and Pre-cast Decking. FOB any point in Deuel County.

10:35 a.m. – Corrugated Metal Culvert. Riveted or spiral and arches.

FOB any point in Deuel County. Delivery, if possible within 48 hours of order, and in continuous lengths of up to 70 feet.

10:50 a.m. – Weed Chemicals as required by the Deuel County Supervisor. Example pricing on 2-4D, Ester & Tordon 22K or generic (Outpost). To be delivered to Deuel County Highway Shop.

All bid envelopes shall be clearly marked as to item bid. All bids shall be quoted FOB Clear Lake and various points specified in Deuel County. By virtue of statutory authority preference may be given to materials produced, or supplies found or produced and manufactured within the State of South Dakota. Where applicable, all materials and supplies shall meet specifications set forth in the “Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges” established by the SD Department of Transportation.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and or all bids, and consider prior history of service or products when awarding bids. It is the policy of Deuel County not to discriminate against the handicapped in employment or the provision of service.
