

July 30, 2018
Special Meeting

The Deuel County Commissioners met in special session on Monday July 30 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room of the Courthouse with Chairman DeJong presiding. Those present were Commissioners Dumke, Jaeger, DeJong, Rhody and Pederson. Also present was Auditor Pam Lynde. The meeting opened with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. 1) Dumke moved, seconded by Pederson to approve the agenda as presented. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Work on 2019 Budget, Health Insurance

The Commissioners and Auditor worked on the requests and funding sources for the proposed 2019 budget.

Deb Lessman, 4-H Advisor discussed 4-H Service Center repairs that are needed; flooring at the center needs to be replaced; lighting at center; may be time to convert to LED lighting; bathrooms need updating.

Deputy Cory Borg also discussed several Sheriff Dept. budget items with the Commissioners.

2) Jaeger moved, seconded by Rhody to approve and publish the provisional budget for 2019 and notice of hearing to be held September 4 at 10:00 a.m. All voted yes, motion carried.

Move Zoning Office, Pay Increases

Employee Scott Ruby Scott Ruby addressed the Commissioners. He asked about permanent cover staff so his work would be covered when he takes time off; to do daily things that need to be done; will be discussed further by the Commissioners; he also requested wage increase.

Discussion was held on the possibility of moving the Zoning Office to the first floor DADi office. The office space would be shared by DADi and the Zoning Office.

3) Pederson moved, seconded by Dumke to move the Zoning Office to the first floor into what is presently the DADi office and share office space. Zoning Office hours 8-5 Monday through Friday. All voted yes and motion carried.



All voted yes and the motion carried.
