Dakota Clovers are responsible for providing meeting refreshments.





NOTE: 4-H membership is not a requirement to participate in this contest. If you are a 4-H member you are encouraged to enter your project in your county fair or achievement event.

The project must demonstrate the following:

1. The student's own research of a nurse's role in healthcare.
2. The student's exploration of specialties in nursing.
3. Educational display and poster exhibits may include, but are not limited to the

Character Education: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, Citizenship

4. Projects entered in Photography must be the original work of the student

Judging Criteria

1. The nursing profession is presented as a positive and noble profession
2. The student demonstrates leadership abilities and self-confidence in pursuing a career in the nursing profession
3. Ability to portray student's goal to become a nurse

Students who enter the contest are invited to a program and pizza party at the South Dakota Nurses Association state convention at the Aberdeen Best Western Ramkota Inn on Sunday, October 6, 2019. This event will begin at 11:00. Winners and awards will be presented at the conventions opening ceremony at 1:00.
