Special Meeting

The Deuel County Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday July 29 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room of the Courthouse with Chairman Pederson presiding. Those present were Commissioners Dumke, Jaeger, Boone, Rhody and Pederson. Also present was Auditor Pam Lynde. 1) Dumke moved, seconded by Rhody to approve the agenda as presented. All voted yes and the motion carried.

9:05 Jamie Hintz

Hintz met with the Commissioners to discuss hiring of full time truck drivers. 2) Upon the recommendation of Hintz Dumke moved, seconded by Jaeger to hire Dallas Olson as full time truck driver/light equipment operator at 11.75 hour as of August 20 and Dana Kenyon as full time truck driver/light equipment operator at 11.75 hour as of August 1 with stipulation Kenyon obtain a CDL license within six months. All voted yes and the motion carried.

9:15 Sheriff Dave Solem

Solem met with the Commissioners to discuss hiring of full time dispatcher. 3) Upon the recommendation of Sheriff Solem Rhody moved, seconded by Boone to hire Debra Gruener as full time dispatcher at 10.50 per hour as of August 1. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Work on 2015 Budget, Health Insurance

The Commissioners and Auditor worked on the requests and funding sources for the proposed 2015 budget. Health insurance and rates for 2014-2015 were discussed. The County's health insurance plan is up for renewal October 1. 4) Dumke moved, seconded by Rhody to approve the renewal of health insurance with the Sanford Health Plan Classic \$1000 deductible single and \$2000 two-party and family; \$10/25/40 Prescription Drug Coverage for the 2014-2015 plan year beginning October 1, 2014. The employee will be responsible for the first \$500/Single and all of the two-party or family deductible, with the county reimbursing the employee for the next \$500/Single with the Auditor's Office administrating the reimbursement plan. All voted yes and the motion carried. 5) Jaeger moved, seconded by Dumke to discontinue offering health insurance benefits to Commissioners beginning January 1, 2015 and to raise Commissioners salary by \$400 per month as of January 1, 2015. All voted yes and the motion carried. 6) Jaeger moved, seconded by Rhody to approve and publish the provisional budget for 2015 and notice of hearing to be held September 2 at 10:00 a.m. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Adjournment

There being no further business, Dumke moved, seconded by Jaeger to adjourn.
